In the name of god amen the seconde daye of Februarye in the yere of our Lorde 1556 I Raffe Adderton of Churchylle in the Countye of oxford husbandman beying sicke of bodye but of sounde and parfette memorye ordeyne and make my last wyll and Testament in manor following, First I doo bequeth and gyve agayne in to the hands of my lorde god my sowle at what tyme yt shall please Hym of his goodnesse and mercye to call for yt and I wyll my body to be buried in the churche yarde of Churchyll Allso I gyve and bequeth to my sonne John Adderton a cowe named Crookehorne and a mattocke, Item to John Harole my dawghter Katherines sonne a browne heyfor All the resydew of my goodes I wyll to remayne to Christian my wyffe and Wyllyam my sonne whom I make my executors These being Wytnesses Wyllyam Kyrry and Thomas Carpynter
