Will of Amy Beaman, widow, of Churchill 1581

In dei no[m]i[n]e I Amye Beareman beinge sicke in bodye nevertheless of good and p[er]fect memorye (god be praysed for the same ) doe make ordene and constitute this my last will and testament the xx th. of August in the yeare of our lord god 1581 in manner and forme followinge first I bequeath my soule unto almighty god my maker and redemer nothinge doubting but that he of his infinite goodness and mercy and by the merits and deathe of his (crossed out) sone jesus christ my savioure will receive my soule into his blessed and perfect?? (can't read) kingdome of heaven and my body I bequeath to the earth from whence hit came to be buried in the p[ar]ish church yard of Church hill It[em] I geve unto Jone my daughter one land of wheate lyinge under Bynehill and one land (all crossed out) of rye lying upo[n] the topp of Bynehill one land of ?? (can't read) in the cotsill one land of barleye lyind in four?? Lyden ?? It[e]m geve ( can't read) unto my daughter elsabethe one lande of wheate at the ???? wisffes???? one farnndell<sup>1</sup> of wheate shootingeon the hythe hedge one lande (can't read) of poulse in the totfild in the smaldole one land of barley in Cas (can't read) furlonge & one land of barley at the Woodsyde It[e]m I give unto (can't read) my daughter one cowe my best basens of brasse my best laver ii platters one cafinge dish ii pottingers one basen of pewter one pewter dish one cubberd one pan one kettle three payre of sheetes one bordclothe one towel one fine chercheffe & one broche It[e]m I give unto my daughter elsabeth one basen of brasse one laver of brasse ii platters one pewter dishe ii caldrons one pott one boultinge which one bedsteed one Fether bed iii payre of sheets one table clothe one towell one fine chercheffe one twillye clothe one boulster one broche and one peese of cloth at the
