Will of William Beard, Yeoman of Sarsden, 1712

In the name of God Amen the fifth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & Twelve I William Beard of Sarsden in the County of Oxon yeoman benig weak in Body but of perfect memory doe make this my last Will & Testem[e]nt in manner following [viz] First I commit my Soul to God my Creator hopeing to be saved thro the merits & Intercession of Jesus Christ & my Body to the Earth to be buried by my Executor after named and as for my worldly Estate I dispose thereof as followeth Impri[mi]s I give and device to my son Thomas Beard & to his heirs & Assigns for ever All my Freehold Lands Tenem[en]ts & Herediterm[en]ts whatsoever Item I give & device all my Messuage & yardland & halfe in Sarsden afores[ai]d now in my possession [which] I hold by Lease from [Sir] William Walter & all other my Leashold lands & Tenem[en]ts unto my s[ai]d son Thomas Beard during so many years of such Loane or Loanes as he shall live paying the Rents & performing the covenants on the Lessees part to be paid and performed And after the death of my son Thomas I give & device the same Messuage & yardland & halfe & other my Leachold lands & Tenem[en]ts to John Griffin of Sarsden afores[ai]d Clerk John Beard of Icomb in the County of Worcester yeoman & Thomas Brooks of Shipton under Whichwood in the s[ai]d County of Oxon yeoman their Exec[ute[rs] Admi[nistrato]rs & Assigns during all the residue of such term or terms as shall be to come in such Leace or Leaces at the death of my s[ai]d son upon such that they & the survivo[rs] of them & the Exec[cuto]rs Admi[nistrato]rs]& Assigns of such surviv[ers] do & shall permit

& suffer such child or children of & body of my s[ai]d son begotten as my s[ai]d son shall by any writing by him signed & sealed in the precnce of two witnisces or more or by his last will &

Testam[en] t appoint & for want of such appoint[en]t the Exec[utor]s or admi[nistrators] of the s[ai]d Thomas Beard

to enjoy the same Leacehold Messuage Lands & tenem[en]ts] during the residue of such term or terms as shall be to come at the death of my said son paynig such rents & performing such covenants

as afores[ai]d. And that the s[ai]d Trustees their Exec[utor]s admin[istrator]s or Assigns do after the death of my said son assign such term or terms & their interest in the same Leashold [phnisces?] to such person or

persons as shall be entitled thereto & the enjoyment thereof as afores[ai]d . All the rest of my personal Estate my debts & funeral expences discharged I give to my s[ai]d son Thomas whom I make Executor of this my last will & Testam[en]t. And I make & appoint the s[ai]d John Griffin John Beard & Thomas Brooks Overseers of this my will desiring them to assist my Exec[utors] in the performance thereof In witnes whereof I have hereto set my hand & seal the day & year first above written Sealed & published by the Testator as his last will & Testam[en]t Wm Beard
