Will of Robert Box, husbandman, of Churchill, 1631

23rd April 1625

In the name of god amen I Robert Boxe of Churchillill in the county of oxon husbandman being sicke in body but of p[er]fecte memorie thanks be given to god doe make my last will & testament in manner & forme as followeth first I will Committ my soule to the hands of Allmightie god hoping to be saved by the merrittes of Jesus Christ my redeemer & my body to be buried in the Church yarde of the p[ar]ish Church of Churchill aforsayde Item I doe give to the p[ar]ish Church of Churchill aforsayde the sum[m]e of three shillings & foure pence Item I doe give unto the poore of Churchill aforsayde the sum[m]e of iii^s 4^d Item I doe give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Izod of Staunton in the County of Worcester the sum[m]e of tenne shillings of Currante English money Item I doe give & bequeath unto my sonne Robert Boxe of Churchill aforsayde the sum[m]e of Fourtie pounds of Currante English money to be payde unto him as when he Commeth to foure & twenty years of age

Item I doe give & bequeath unto my sonne Richard the Sum[m]e of fourtie pounds of Currante English money to be payde unto him pr[e]sently after my deceasse Item I doe give & bequeath to my my brother John Boxe the sum[m]e of twentie shillings of Currant English money to be payde unto him w[i]thin one yeare after my deceasse Item I doe Constitute apoynte & ordeyne My wife Anne Boxe to be my soule executor & to pay the legacies & dues that I have herin given & bequeathed and also I doe Intreate my brother John Boxe & my neighbour Anthony Crosse to be my overseers of this my last will & testament Written Read & subscribed in the pr[e]sence of us Edmunde Glynne John Boxe Robert Boxes Q marke Anthony Crosse
