In the name of God Amen I John Boxe in the County of Oxon husbandman beinge sicke in bodie but on good and p[er]fecte memorie thanks be to God doe make this my last will and Testament in manner and forme as followeth Item I give three shillinge to t[he] Church of Churchill Item I give two shillings to the poore of the same Item I give to mydaughter Catherine Seaven pounds w[i]thin one yeare after my decease to be payed Item I give to my daughter Joane three pound Item I give to my sonn Thomas six pound Item I give to my daughter Sara Foure pound Item I give to my daughter Anne three pound Item Igive to my daughter Alice three pound Item I give to my daughter Marie three pound Item-I doe give to my daughter Ellianor my best cow and a little Tableboard Item I doe give to my daughter Elizabeth one shillinge My will is th[a]t these my three daughters Anne Marie and Alice shall stay two yeares for their porcous I doe give my daughter Ellianor one brasse pott I doe make my wife and my sonn Richard my whole and sole Executors of this my will.
