Will of Annes Bud, of Churchill, 1573

In the name of god Amen the xx daye of Februarie in the yeare of o[ur] lorde god 1573 I Annes Bud beinge sike in bodye but whole and P[er]fytt in remembrance thanke be unto allmightie god Docta ordenie Make this my testament, last wylein manner, forme Followinge First I bequeathe my soule unto allmightie god my maker & redeemer And my bodyeto be buried inin the churche yearde of all saintes in Churche hill It[e]m I bequeathe to Jane my Daughter & my sonne John

My parte of any crope bothe in the Fyled and in the barne It[e]m I Geve to my daughter Joane a pott woorte panne a payre of sheettes & a cubborde a pygge Three hennes and a cocke the best candlestick a lynnen whele & awollen whele & two barrelles a kever the best upstande a little yre and a seserne It[e]m I give to my sonne John a payre of shettes a brasse panne a longe sheyeke & two peser of pewter It[e]m I give to Thomas my sonne halfe a quarter of malte bushel of wheat & a bushell of Rye Allso the greater Sethern & a trou ge a table borde, a table a lathe sorine a payre of sheetes a pewter cuppe two polengers & a ketyll It[e]m I wyll that Willym and Thomas shall have my parte of the next Fallowe – betwixt them It[e]m I give to my sonne Wyllyam a bushel of wheate & a bushel of Rye a bushel of barley and a bushel of pulse to be payed at the hands of John & Jone, oute of the croppe, It[e]m I will that Thomas Whytley shall holde & continewe upon the boryanie that was Betwixt him & me for the tillage & all other covenants tyll mycha ellmas cum twelvemonth to bee the p[er]formance of my legacies fulfylled. All the rest of my goodes unbequeathed I give & bequeath unto John my sonne & Joane my daughter whom I ordaine & make my trewe & lawfull executors to see me honestlye brought to the

earthe, These being witnesses Sir Humfrey Bowyer John Adderton Wyll[ia]m Kyryre Thomas Whitlye Wyll[ia]m Turner w[i]th others
