Imprimis the said Agnes Collins beinge upon her death bed and beinge in perfect mind & memory she gave unto Jone Collins Dorathie Collins & Willi[a]m Collins <del>her -----</del> unto each of them iiij<sup>Li</sup> unto Elizabeth Fernsyde iiij<sup>Li</sup> unto Annis Fernsyde iij<sup>Li</sup> And the rest of her goodes she gave unto Francis Collins whome she made her Executor and these words were spoken in the presence of the witness hereunder wrytten.
