The Testament and last will nuncupative of
Agnes Collins of Sarsden in the
dioc[esse] of Oxon made and declared by her
by word of mouth about the month of June
1608 as followeth vid

Imprimis the said Agnes Collins beinge upon her death bed
and beinge in perfect mind & memory she gave unto Jone
Collins Dorathie Collins & Willi[a]m Collins ~~her~~ unto
each of them ^{li} unto Elizabeth Fernsyde ^{li} unto
Annis Fernsyde ^{li} And the rest of her goodes she
gave unto Francis Collins whome she made her
Executor and these words were spoken in the presence
of the witness hereunder wrytten.
