Memorand[um] that Christopher Hunt late of Churchill in the County of Oxon deceased --lying sick of the sicknes whereaf he dyed did viz

1620 declare his last will and testam[en]t nu[n]cupative
by word of mouth as followeth --- That is to say
----- he did give and bequeath all his goodes
whatsoev[er] unto Joane Huntt his wyfe and did make
her his executrix, John Adderton, Robert Jeffrey
and the said Joane beinge then pr[e]sent
