Will of William Kyrrie, 1579

In the name of god amen I wylliam Kyrrie being sycke
 in mynde and of good memorie make and ordayne thys
 my laste will and testament in manere and forme
 followinge fyrste I bequethe my soule into the handes of all
 myghtye god and my bodye to be buriede in the churchyard
 of Churchill I geve and bequeath to ane my Daughter xx^s
 allso I geve to george my sonne xx^s I geve to John my
 sonne xx^s I geve to John my sonne the yonger xx^s and I
 geve to thomas my sonne xx^s and I make elizabethe my
 wife my executore of all my goodes that is onbequestyd
 moveabule and onmoveabule my dettes beinge payed
 the xxiiij Daye of febrooarye in the xxjth yere of the
 raygne of oure Soveravgne ladye quen^e elyzabethe by the
 grace of god quen^e of englande franncce and Ireland defender of
 the faythe etc of Wytneseth Symom harrys
