Will of Roger Medcroft, husbandman, of Churchill, 1693

In the name of God Amen. I Rog^r. Medcroft of Churchill in the County of Oxon being of perfect mind & memory (praysed be Almighty God for it) butt weak in body doe make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament (invoking all others whattso.v.^r) in manner and form as followeth

- First I bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty God my maker hoping¹y through the meritts of Jesus Christ my saviour & redeemer to serve first pardon & forgiv.n.ss of all my sinns
- Ip. I give my body to th^e grave to bee buried in decent manner att the discretion of my Executor herein after mentioned
- Ip. I give unto my true & well beloved son Henry Medcroft yeoman the House within I now dwell with My house thereunto belonging.
- Ip I give unto my afforesaid son all th^e Free Land that I now possess & enjoy within th^e liberty of Churchill affors^d. and to his Heirs for ever.
- Ip I give unto my true and well beloved wife Elizabeth
 Medcroft the sum of four pounds by th^e year, to be paid
 twenty shillings quarterly to her during the term of her
 naturall life if she the said Elizabeth shall remove
 from my son by whom my will is the same should be paid.
- Ip. I give unto my daughter Ann Higgins one shilling.
- Ip. All the rest of my house Goods Lands and Chattls move= ably and immoveably I give unto my son Henry and him I make and appoint the sole and whole Executor of this my last will & Testament In wittness whose of I have sett my hand and seal this Twentith day of March in the fourth year of the Reign of our sovoreigns Lord and

Lady, King William and Queen Mary & of th^e year of our Lord God 1692
