Will of Henry Midcraft, Yeoman, of Churchill, 1600

In the name of god Amen I Henrie midcraft of Churchill in the countie of Oxon Beinge sicke in Bodie But of good and p[er]fect rememberance thanks Be to God I doe make this my last will and testament the xviijth daye of Aprill in the yeare of oure lord god 1598 in mannor and forme followinge First I Bequeathe my soule to almightie god and my Bodie to the grounde It[em] I give unto Roger midcraft my sonn[e] the house I now dwell in wythe the apuppurtenances all my freie lande in Churchill my Best pott my Best pan and my ioned Bedsteede. It[em] I give unto Jhon midcrafte my sonne and to w[illia]m mullington my sonne in lawe ij trees growing in my ricke yarde my Sonne having his choice It[em] I give unto Henrie midcraft sonne unto Roger midcraft one sheepe and one paire of sheetes It[em] I give unto Richard midcraft son[n]e unto jhon midcraft one sheepe and one paire of sheetes Item I give unto An[n]e mullington one paire of sheetes Item I give unto Jhon midcraft my sonne my two kline The rest of all my goodes as well moveable as unmoveable I give unto Jhon midcraft my sonne and to Ales mullingto[n] my daughter who my will is shall equally devide the same Betwixt the[m] I doe make Roger midcraft my Sonne my whole and sole executor
