Will of Elizabeth Minchin, widow, of Churchill, 1670

In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Minchin of  
Churchill in the County of Oxon widow being sicke  
in body but of p[er]fect memorie thanks be given to God  
doe make and ordeyne this my last Will & Testament  
the sixteenth Day of March Ano D[omi]ni one thousand sixe  
hundered sixty & nyne and in the two & twentieth  
year of the reigne of Kinge Charles the s[e]cond now  
Kinge of England etc In manner & forme as followe[t]h  
First I Comitt my soule into the hands of almighty  
God hopinge to be saved by the passion of Jesus Christ  
& my bodie to be buried in the Churchyard of the parish  
Church of Churchill afores[ai]d & of my worldly Goodes as  
Followeth In primis I give to my brother Richard Lucas the  
Sume of foure pounds of lawful money of England to be  
payde w[ith]in one year next after my desease Item I give  
unto my kinsman David Lucus the son of my brother Richard  
Lucas the sume of three pounds of lawful money of  
England to be paide w[ith]in one yeare next after my decease  
Item I give to my kinsman John Rouke of Spelsburie  
The sume of five Shillings Item I give unto my kingswoman  
Anne Rouke five shillings Item I give unto Anne Lucas  
the daughter of my brother Richard Lucas Tenn Shillings  
Item I give to Alice Lucas the daughter of my brother  
Richard Lucas Tenn Shillings Item I give to Anne Lucas  
one flockbed one bolster one blanket one paire of sheetes  
one Coverlet Item I give to Alice Lucas one flockbed  
one bolster one blanket one paire of sheets one Coverlett

Item I give to my sister Dorothe Bayles five shillings

Item I doe appoint and ordayne my kinsman Richard

Lucas the son of my brother Richard Lucas to be my

Sole Executor In witness whereof I have to this my

last will & Testament the sixteenth day of march as

above written & sett my hand & seale
