In name [of god] domini anney the 10<sup>th</sup> of February beying the tenth yeare of o[ur] Soferayne ladie Quene Elizabeth I Alice Myddleton of Sarsden in the County of oxon wedowe beying sicke in body and whole in mynd and perfett remembrance doe this make my last wyll and Testament in manner and forme followinge First I bequeath my soule to allmyhtye god my body to be buryed in the churche yard of Churchill Also I geve to dorothye Mynchin my daughter my blew gowne and my whyte petycote and to anerthe[r] one of her children one pewter dysshe All the rest of my goods moveable and unmoveable I geve to Edwarde my sonne and to Thomas my sonne that is to saye Edwarde to lane two parth and Thomas to lane one parte Allso I make Edwarde my sonne my whole executor to see this my last wyll and Testamente p[er]formed my detts payed my funerall discharged These bearinge wytnesse Francis dinkott parson of Sarsden Symon Harris and Robert Clapton withothers moo
