Will of John Mynchen, of Churchill, 1557

In the name of god amen the xxvj day of Maye in the yere of o[ur] lorde god 1557 I John Mynchen of churchyll beynge sownde of mynde althoughe sycke in body make my testament or last wyll in maner & forme folowynge first I be quethe my soule to almyghty god & my bodye to be buried in the churche yarde of churchyll It[e]m I geve & bequethe to John my sone the take of the close after the maryage of hys mother I gyve to the same John a yrne bounde carte a plough ij harrose W[ith] all thynge belongynge there unto shepe iiii copulles & a baren ewe the redde kowe the White colte & halfe Wyth hys mother throught oute the hole besyde thys I geve to the chylde that she gothe w[ith] all a falowe kowe a Whyie grey horse & the thirde parte w[ith] hys mother and yf she be nott w[i]t[h] chylde then she to have halfe w[ith] John and yf it plese god that any of these chiderne dye the hole to remayne to the other and yf they bothe dy than that good to remayne to the chylderne of Will[ia]m mynche[n] my brother & Jane Warde my sister save xx^s to be payde to the churche towarde the roode loft It[e]m I gyve to the mother churche of oxford ij^d I gyve to the highe aulter churche ligt vij^d to the belles xii^d & to the makynge of the [?] mary & John xii^d and also it is my Wyll that after the p[ro]bacion of the testament my brother Will[ia]m shall se the & honetlye ordeyne of thys goodes to the p[ro]sette of childerne also I make alys my Wyfe sole Executrix to p[er]forme thys my p[re]sent will and I bequethe to ij of my god childerne a lande of barle lyenge in beseden slad these beinge Wyttnesses Sye omfrey bower vicar Will[ia]m mynchen

overseer John ^{Hall} peter mynchen w[ith] other Dettes owing to me John pytt of Charlebury xxvj^s Wattes of kyngham a serteyne of money whiche my wife knoweth of John netsche v^s - $iiij^d$ & [?] bushell of barley thomas churley xx^d a bushell barley & ij lode of wod Dettes w[hich] I o[w]ighe to wattes of kyngham one bushell of barley
