Will of Austine Sheller, husbandman, of Sarden, 1633

In the name of god Amen etc The ninth Daye of Aprill Anno D[omi]ni 1633 I Austine Sheller of Saresden in the Countye & diocesse of Oxon husbandman sicke in bodye but of p[er]fect remembrance doe make my last will & Testament thus viz Inp[ri]mis I com[m]end my soule my principalle part into the hands of god ny creator & mercifull father by the meritts & Death of whose only sonne Jesus Christ I hope & beeleve to be saved both in soule & bodye And my bodye I yeeld unto the ground whence it was taken & to bee laid in Chr[isti]an buriall As for those goods w[hi]ch god hath lent mee & w[hi]ch I nowe possesse I give & bequeath as followeth Inp[ri]mis I give and bequeath to my three Children three pounds a peece of lawfull Englishe money to be paid to them pr[e]sently after my deceasse & further my will is that the aforesaid legacies shall be paid & delivered into the hands of mr Francis Haslewoode & John Rawlines to be emploied to the best benefitt & behoofe of my children untill they come of sufficient age to use it them selves Ite[m] I give to my sonne Austine Sheller my Bible to bee Delivered unto him when hee comes to sufficient Age to use it Ite[m] I give to my sonne Austine Sheller & to my Daughter Jane Sheller one yewe A peece to be delivered to the p[ar]ties aforesaid to bee emploied to theire use The residue of my goodes and chattells unbequeathed I give and bequeath to Margery my lawfull wife whome I make sole Executrixe of this my last will & Testament & I doe appointe & ordaine my well beloved in Christ Francis Haslewoode & Jhon Rawlines Overseers of the same And in Testimonie that this is my last will & Testament I have heereunto sett my hande and seale the daye & yeare first above written
